BACK TO SCHOOL ISSUE!!!

The 2016-2017 school year is approaching and teachers and administrators are finishing their checklists. The checklists include changing the layout of the high school building, updating technology, revamping curriculum, and preparing new teachers and staff.

At the end of the school year a committee of teachers gathered with Mr. Conn to discuss the layout of the second and third floor of the junior high and high school building. The committee recommended rearranging rooms to assist with class sizes and allow teachers to communicate effectively within subject areas. A few of the subject area rooms that are moving are high school math, middle school language arts, and science. High school math will be located on the second floor in the old language arts room. Middle school language arts will be in the old high school math room on the third floor. Science room

will still be on the third floor, but will be in the old FACS room. Mrs. Calfee is very excited to have additional space for students to work and prepare labs.

Not only, are rooms being rearranged, but thanks to Mrs. Herndon's skills and dedication to North Nodaway, she is restoring computers and adding them to classrooms for enrichment and reinforcement assignments. She is working on adding computers to Mrs. Smail's junior high math room. Mrs. Smail is preparing her curriculum so she can focus on assisting a smaller group while the other group works on enrichment and reinforcement assignments and the groups will rotate. Mrs. Herndon is also ordering new technology for Mrs. Frueh. Mrs. Frueh applied for an enhancement grant in February and received approval at the end of June for new technology for the business room. Mrs. Frueh applied for new laptops, chrome books, printers,

dslr camera, interactive projector, and Adobe and Microsoft software.

Students will notice changes to the building and will also welcome several new teachers. The new personal are Courtney McDaniel, Sami Jackson, Joni Voss, Kit Meiners, Chris Young, Owen Miller, Cody Marriott, Jon Webber, and Lindsay Jackson. Courtney McDaniel, Joni Voss, and Sami Jackson will be joining the elementary staff. Courtney will be the new preschool teacher, Joni will be the music teacher and Sami will assist teachers as a paraprofessional. Kit Meiners will be sharing her time between elementary and high school buildings as the counselor. The community will also see Kit assisting

with the softball team this fall. Chris Young is the new junior high and high school history teacher. Owen Miller has been selected as the language arts teacher. Cody Marriott is joining the physical education department and will also be assisting the football team. Jon Webber was selected as the middle school and high school band teacher. Another familiar face will join the high school as a paraprofessional, Lindsay Jackson.

Elementary Registration

Elementary registration for all students, preschool through fifth grade, will be held Wednesday, August 3rd and Thursday, August 4th, from 8:00 am – 6:00pm. All elementary families will be required to bring an address verification such as a rental contract, real estate contract, utilities bill/deposit receipt, or other documents such as

payroll check, driver's license, or W-4. Also, please remember to bring along any emergency phone numbers as two emergency contacts are required. If you are enrolling a student new to our district, in addition to the above items, please be sure to bring a copy of their birth certificate, Social Security card, and immunization record.

Preschool Registration

Just a reminder to parents of all students who will enter Preschool that registration will be held at the same time as the elementary registration on Wednesday, August 3rd and Thursday, August 4th, from 8:00 am – 6:00pm. Also, please remember to bring along two emergency phone numbers and 911 addresses as these are required. There are

forms in addition to the forms filled out last spring which must be completed and turned in at this time. If you have not already done so, please bring your child's Social Security card, birth certificate, immunization record and medical exam. These are required before your child may attend Preschool.

Parents as Teachers

Parents as Teachers is a voluntary program offered through local districts through the state of Missouri. The parent educator provides parenting information and age appropriate child development information and activities to parents of children ages prenatal through kindergarten entry. We anticipate limited Parents as

Teachers visits this year due to some state funding cuts.
